

Waterlily

Class Description: In this small art quilt class, students learn how to choose fabrics for each petal or leaf, and shade with ink if needed. We will use the prepared edge appliqué technique to make our shapes, and then hand sew your flower to a pieced background. Sandra will have ink on hand for class use.

Supplies needed:

“Waterlily” Pattern by Sandra Mollon

Kit (\$40): Fabrics for the quilt top, including hand dyed cottons in greens, pinks to peach tones, and yellow-orange, and blue (pieced) background.

Additional supplies needed:

Light box (if you own one-optional)

Pencil with an eraser

Small iron (travel iron) and ironing mat

Roxanne’s Glue Baste it

Milliner’s needles (size 10-11)

#100 Silk thread (YLI recommended) in a light to medium beige color.

Spray sizing (1 can), and a small dish, jar or lid to spray it into.

A small 1/4” stencil brush

Scissors for fabric and paper

Stiletto (helpful to have)

Pearls appliqué turning tool (highly recommended)

Freezer paper, 1 yard
