

Geraniums

Fabric:

- ¾ yard background: cream
- 1 yard frame, inner bowl and binding: dark blue or red
- ¼ yard yellow beige for table top
- ⅓ yard doily: white, bring your own or purchase precut
- 12" x 9" marbled print for bowl
- ¼ yard golden brown for table edge
- ¼ yard each of 5 greens for leaves or ¾ yard ombre green for leaves and stems
- ¼ yard dark green for stems
- ⅓ yard of each of 4 solid reds for geraniums or purchase precut
- ¼ yard dark grey transparent tulle for shadow
- 1⅓ yard batting and backing

Notions:

- Pattern \$10, may order ahead at whispercolor.com
- \$13 Laser cut doily shapes
- \$7 Laser cut blossom shapes
- Kit \$66, includes pattern, all fabrics for the top and binding, and laser cut doily shapes and blossoms.
- Scissors for paper and sharp pointed scissors for fabric. (My favorites are Famor and Kia)
- Pencil and pen, black and red
- Scotch tape
- School glue-stick or Scholastic glue-stick, white
- Applique needles (My favorite is Bohem #10)
- Thimble, pins, needle threader
- Poly Pellets, 1-2 pounds
- 4 Sandwich sized ziploc bags
- ¼" Bias tape maker -optional
- Thread to match fabrics
- Golden yellow thread or red #11 sized round seed beads
- Beading needle
